Some dogs come from loving families who fell upon financial hardship. Some come to us from shelters and have never been shown attention or love. Not only does fostering help MAGSR with kenneling costs, it helps prepare the dog to succeed in a home. With dogs in foster, there is so much more they can learn that will better prepare them for their new home. It also helps MAGSR place them into a new home with more information about the dogs behaviors and needs.
